1. Your data

Mark Devereux Projects collects and stores the following data for everyone who signs up to our mailing list:

- Name
- Email address
- Website

2. Data Controller

Mark Devereux Projects is the data controller (contact details below).

3. How do we process your personal data?

Mark Devereux Projects complies with its obligations under the “GDPR” by keeping personal data up to date; by storing and destroying it securely; by not collecting or retaining excessive amounts of data; by protecting personal data from loss, misuse, unauthorised access and disclosure and by ensuring that appropriate technical measures are in place to protect personal data. We use your personal data for the following purposes: -

- To inform you of news, events, activities and opportunities via our monthly newsletter

4. What is the legal basis for processing your personal data?

- Explicit consent so that we can keep you informed about news, events, activities and opportunities

5. Sharing your data

- We will never sell or forward your information to a third party under any circumstances

6. How long do we keep your personal data?

We will keep your data on record for five years, unless you unsubscribe or withdraw consent. This arrangement will be reviewed every after five years.

7. Your rights and your personal data

Unless subject to an exemption under the GDPR, you have the following rights with respect to your personal data: -

- The right to request a copy of your personal data which Mark Devereux Projects holds about you.
- The right to request that Mark Devereux Projects corrects any personal data if it is found to be inaccurate or out of date;
- The right to request your personal data is erased where it is no longer necessary for Mark Devereux Projects to retain such data;
- The right to withdraw your consent to the processing at any time
- The right to request that the data controller provide the data subject with his/her personal data and where possible, to transmit that data directly to another data controller, (known as the right to data portability), (where applicable) [*Only applies where the processing is based on consent or is necessary for the performance of a contract with the data subject and in either case the data controller processes the data by automated means*].
- The right, where there is a dispute in relation to the accuracy or processing of your personal data, to request a restriction is placed on further processing;
- The right to lodge a complaint with the Information Commissioners Office.

8. Further processing

If we wish to use your personal data for a new purpose, not covered by this Data Protection Notice, then we will provide you with a new notice explaining this new use prior to commencing the processing and setting out the relevant purposes and processing conditions. Where and whenever necessary, we will seek your prior consent to the new processing.
